The other terrier-breeds have there specially clubs – for example the Airedale terrier. In our club we have about 470 members – from Austria, Belgium, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, Hungary, Italy, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia, and Switzerland.

We have in Austria about 35 kennels. Every year we can register about 100 new dogs.

In Austria every year we have 12 international dog shows with about 80 dogs from our breeds and 2 club shows.
